Pests	When to Spray	Solution - spray with:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Aphids • Thrips • Mealy Bug 	Whenever present, these sap suckers weaken the plant and can spread diseases.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rose Shield (Yates) • Confidor or • White Oil
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scale 	Whenever present, scale can cause dieback and poor growth.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • White Oil or • Pest oil • Lime sulphur in Winter
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two-spotted mite 	Whenever present, causes mottled dry silvery foliage.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Miticide / Natrasoap (Yates) or • Sulphur
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Caterpillars 	Whenever present. Caterpillars such as the Apple Moth and Budworms feed on the flowers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Biological control eg • Dipel or • Success
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Weevils (Fuller's Rose Weevil) 	Whenever present. Spray when they feed at night as they are difficult to spot because they hide around the base of the plant during the night. They are active during Summer and Autumn.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Marrik or • Carbaryl leaf chewing insecticide

Disease	When to Spray	Solution - spray with:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Powdery Mildew 	Whenever present, fungal disease appears as white, powdery growth on leaves.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fungicide eg Lime Sulphur • Fungus Gun (Yates) or • Mancozeb
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sooty Mould 	Whenever present, fungal disease usually caused by honeydew left by feeding insects.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • White Oil to get rid of the insect and it will also get rid of the sooty mould.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Black Spot 	Whenever present first appears as black leaf spots then progresses to yellow leaves. It can weaken the rose and lead to smaller blooms.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Triforine Rose fungicide or • Bayer Rose and Ornamental Spray
