



Good Water Management

- Water deeply and less frequently - encouraging the roots to grow deeply instead of light watering more often which produces surface roots that can dry out in hot or windy weather. If the water runs off, use Saturaid or Soil Wetta to help absorption.
- Check moisture levels in pots with your fingers to ensure the plant really does need watering.
- The use of seaweed products such as Maxicrop and Seasol help the soil retain water and help the plant develop strong cells to cope with stress such as drought.
- Mulch in the hot weather - before spreading mulch, water deeply then spread the mulch over the top. Do not spread mulch right up to the trunk of the plants, leave about 20cm (6") around it.
