'Black Pantha' Agapanthus



The long-stemmed 'Black Pantha' has a commanding presence. Each flower displays a mass of florets of intense deep flower colour giving it an almost black appearance. The form of the flower cluster is unique as the upper flowers tend to remain closed while the outer florets open and drop to the side maintaining the blackness of the cluster.

Multi-flowering from a single plant makes this agapanthus unique amongst the large agapanthus species. Extended flowering of up to 12 weeks begins in early November; secondary flowering in April then provides another season of colour.

The non-deciduous nature of 'Black Pantha' means abundant, long, green foliage all year round, a feature which separates it from other dark-flowering varieties. Recent tests for vase life as a cut flower indicate excellent results under normal conditions.

'Black Pantha' was released in Australia during Spring 2002.
